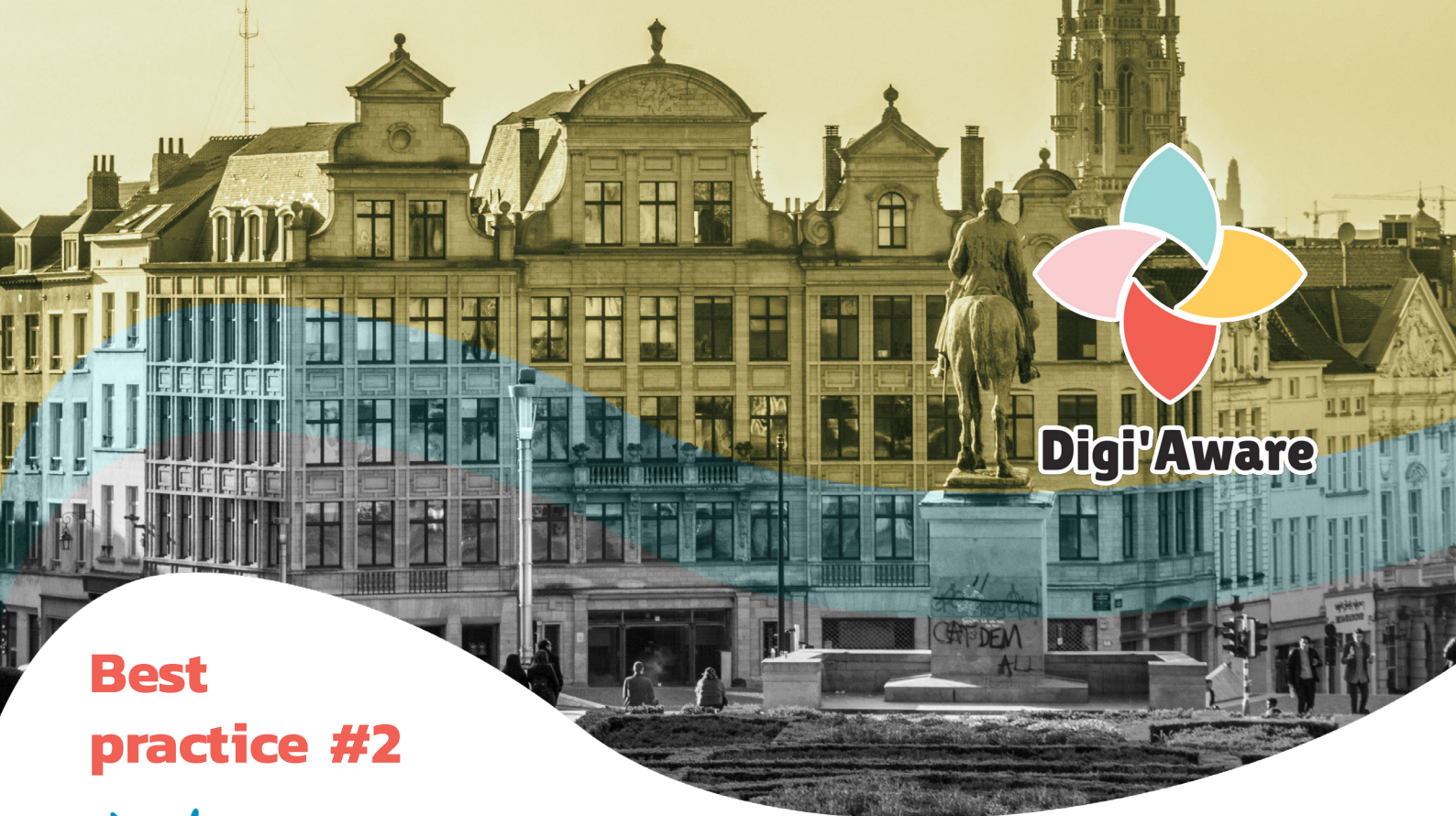

Theme/Focus Area

Online safety, responsible behaviour, safe internet use, cyberbullying prevention

Description of the practice

Clicksafe is Child Focus's flagship awareness-raising and educational programme. It provides interactive workshops, training materials, and awareness campaigns to equip children and young people with the skills to navigate the online world safely. It also offers training for teachers and parents to support discussions on online risks and opportunities.

Results/ Impact

- Over 60.000 children and young people reached annually.
- Positive feedback from schools: teachers report better preparedness to address online risks.
- Hotline and helpline services linked to the programme provide real-world impact in safeguarding.

Transferability/Innovation

Clicksafe's mix of interactive workshops + awareness campaigns + direct support services is highly transferable. The innovative element is the integration of prevention (education) with protection (helplines and reporting services).
